

ELIGIBILITY:

Any student in the Public, Parochial, or Private Schools of Stark County is eligible to participate in the contest, from kindergarten through 8th grade. Categories will be as follows: Kindergarten - 2nd grade; 3nd - 5th grade; and 6th - 8th grade. Each student may submit only **ONE INDIVIDUAL** entry and the art work must be the original art work of the contestant.

POSTER SIZE:

Posters must be submitted on standard size 22" X 28" poster board of any thickness. This is the standard size sold by all office and art supply stores and most drug and discount stores.
