A second show will take place on Saturday night, with the doors opening at 6:30 p.m. and curtain at 7:00 p.m. with a \$25.00 admission.

The Stark County Bar Association premiered our probono, legal outreach production of "Twelve Angry Men" for Law Week in 2009, sixteen years ago, at the Kathleen Howland Theatre in the 2nd April Galerie. Our Past President, Joe Martuccio got the idea for that production during a late-night viewing of the movie version on television. The production was set in the 1950s and was performed over a nine-year period in Canton, Minerva, Alliance, Massillon and Valley City, Ohio. The original players included 12 men and one woman from various areas of practice and the production was offered as a "gift to the community – an enlightening, entertaining and enduring constitutional 'lesson' on the Bill of Rights."

We should all be proud to be affiliated with an organization that is dedicated to ensuring that our community is provided with means to ensure that their legal rights are protected and zealously pursued by quality attorneys.

Many opportunities exist in our community to volunteer on a pro bono basis. Moving from private practice to the Family Court bench, I have become increasingly aware of the needs of people who find themselves in court by choice or by fate. Pro se litigants with limited income can easily access forms with basic instructions online for all our Stark County Courts and in most jurisdictions across the State of Ohio. If

additional help is needed, many jurisdictions offer help desks staffed by law students, paralegals and attorneys to guide litigants. In Stark County, Community Legal Aid provides an assortment of assistance to individuals who qualify, including legal clinics, pro bono and lowcost attorney fee services to clients. The Stark Family Court has established a Help Desk that aids any pro se litigant who appears during the time the Help Desk is open. The desk is staffed by experienced Family Law attorneys who work for a set reduced hourly rate on a limited scope basis, providing help at no charge to the public on a first-come, first-served basis. New attorney participants are always welcome for this highly sought after service. On Saturday, November 1, 2025 the Stark County Bar Association Pro Bono Committee will be joining with Krugliak, Wilkins, Griffiths & Dougherty, Co., L.P.A. to host a Driver's License Reinstatement Clinic from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. at St. Paul's Episcopal Church at 425 Cleveland Ave. SW, Canton, Ohio 44702. This service can be life-changing to those in need. Please consider making pro bono service a part of your practice!


